This is in continuation of our earlier letter dated 06.09.2021 bearing No.BCI:D:1044 (LE/Data) whereby some information was sought with regard to Taluka places nearest to your Institution where your senior students could visit and provide Legal aid to the needy, helpless and poor people.

Now, you are requested to kindly provide the information as per format attached with this letter latest by 9th September, 2021 through email on email ID-bci.legalaid@gmail.com.

The aforementioned information should reach the Bar Council of India latest by 9th September, 2021 on the email ID noted above/below. You should also suggest the names of at least 25-30 students, whom you think appropriate and competent for the purpose of providing Legal aid, alongwith the contact details of the In-Charge Teacher, who looks after Legal Aid matters.

The names forwarded by the Institution should be deserving names as those students will be required to act as Para-Legal workers and will be assigned the task by the nearest District Judges/Authorities under Legal Services Authorities Act. You are also to inform whether the Legal Aid Clinic of your Institution is working and serving the people of the area.

The students may get reasonable incentives from Legal Services Authorities, if found suitable.

You were also requested and directed to furnish the number of the students who are in final year LL.B (with the course subject). Uptil now, no information has been received from your end. Please furnish the details in Excel Format on or before 9th September, 2021 in this regard also as per format (Excel) attached.

If you fail to furnish the information on or before 9th September, 2021, it will be presumed that your Institution has no Legal Aid Clinic (as required under the Rules of Legal Education of Bar Council of India) and/or you are not holding the classes regularly. The consequences would follow.

Treat it as most urgent and important.
